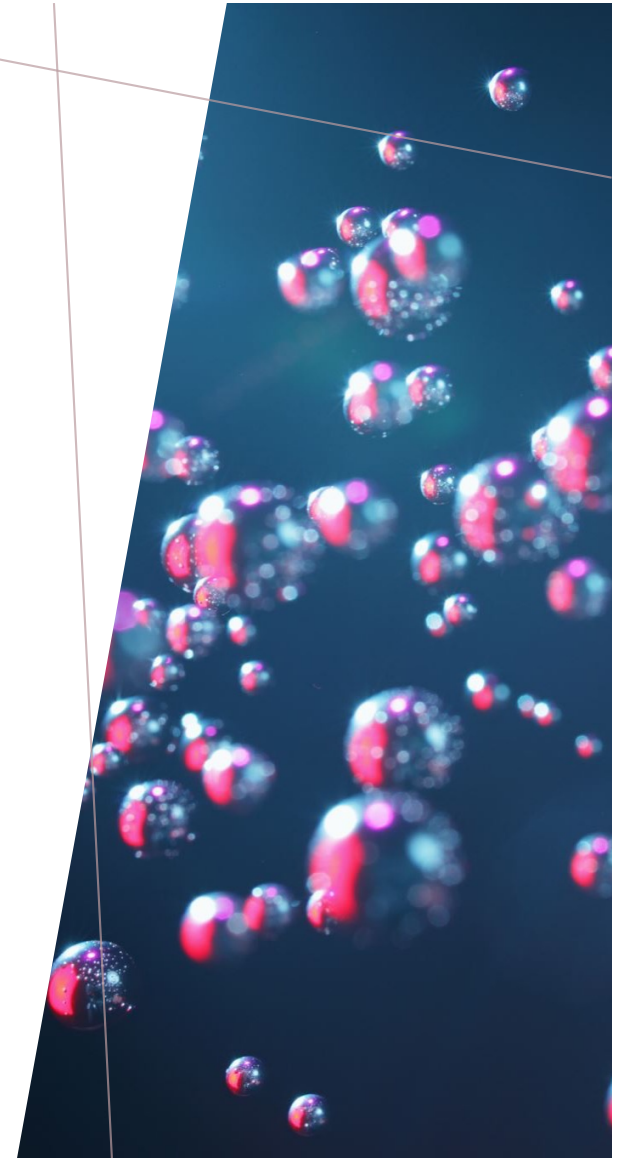

On this day we will need you to email us, **by 3PM** using a template that we will send to you...

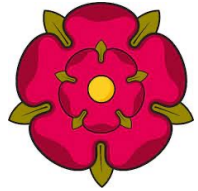
- Telling us that you want to do your A Levels at LGGS
